Pan Am Region SCCA Solo Supplementary Rules



1. Minor Participation Waivers

- a. Minors aged 12 -18 years who will be in the "Hot" areas (eg grid, course) of an event as drivers, workers, riders, or volunteers must have submitted valid waivers.
 - i. The waivers have two parts and must be signed by the minor and both their parents (unless one parent has sole custody in which case that parent must affirm that on the waiver).
 - ii. Waivers can be completed in front of an adult SCCA member or in front of a notary public and notarized.
 - iii. Printed waivers must be completed **IN COLOR**, black and white copies will not be accepted.
- b. Waiver forms are available on scca.com -> Online Store -> Licenses & Waivers
- c. Minor waiver requirements are discussed in 2022 Solo Rule Book, Section 2.5
- d. Minors under the age of 12 years are **not allowed** in "Hot" areas under any circumstances.

2. 4 Wheel Drive or High Center of Gravity Vehicles

- a. Due to the increased chance of rollovers, 4 wheel drive vehicles (not AWD) or vehicles with a high center of gravity and a narrow track are not allowed. Examples of excluded vehicles include but are not limited to:
 - b. Any vehicle on light truck rated tires.
 - c. Any vehicle with a 4wheel drive transfer case. Any full size van.
 - d. Any mini-van.
 - e. Any vehicle with a lift kit.
 - f. Any vehicle with a wheelbase exceeding 116 inches.
 - g. Any vehicle deemed by the Solo Chairman, Event Chairman, or Solo Safety Steward to be at risk of a rollover.
- 3. Examples of vehicles: Suzuki Samurai, Jeep CJ series, Geo Sidekick, Chevy Blazer, Ford Explorer, Dodge Caravan, Honda Odyssey, Ford F150 4WD, Dodge Ram 4WD, Chevy Silverado 4WD

- 4. Course finish and timing lights
 - a. Drivers are to finish their run with the car in control.
 - i. If any cones are hit after the finish lights, the run will be scored as a DNF.
 - ii. If the driver does not come to a complete and total stop within the finish zone, the run will be scored as a DNF
 - b. If any driver hits any timing device there will be a \$100 fine (the cost to replace one part of the timing system). If this driver hits the timing lights on any more of their runs, they will forfeit the rest of their runs, but will still be required to stay for their worker assignment if it has not been completed. They may also be asked to not attend any other Pan Am Solo events for the season, at the discretion of the Solo Chair and Chiefs.

5. No pseudonyms or nicknames

a. All drivers must use the name listed on their SCCA members card and/or their state issued driver's license.

6. No Smoking in HOT areas

a. There will be NO smoking in hot areas. Hot areas are defined as grid and course. The NO smoking rule includes cigarettes, cigars, vape machines, e-cigarettes, or any other "smoking" device.
